Mid-City Residents Organize to Move SR-15 Project Forward

**Success for the CenterLine Rapid Transit!
A Win for Mid-City Residents!**

At the last SANDAG Board of Directors Meeting on November 30th, 2007, the following outcomes took place:

- 1. The Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was certified after much advocating by Mid-City residents**
- 2. The 2030 RTP Revenue Constrained Plan was found to be in conformance with the State Implementation Plans for air quality**
- 3. Due to the pressure from Mid-City residents, the Final 2030 RTP was approved with the following additional language related to the Mid-City Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) plans, "Dedication or construction of additional lanes for HOV or other uses in the SR 15 Mid – City Segment of I-15 is contingent on the completion and operation of Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Stations and system improvements pursuant to agreements between the State and City of San Diego."**
